#### Amendment to New York Cybersecurity Regulation 23 NYCRR 500

The New York State Department of Financial Services (NYDFS) issued an amendment to its cybersecurity regulation, which was finalized on November 1, 2023. Any financial professionals who reside in New York or who do business in New York should closely review the following information.

It is important to review the definition of "covered entity" in Section 500.1(e) and read Section 500.19 to determine whether the regulation may apply to you. If it is determined the regulation applies to you, you should review the entirety of the amendment to ensure compliance, or seek legal counsel and/or a cyber consultant.

Materials submitted through AdView prior to the January 1, 2022 must be resubmitted into RegEd communications review before March 15, 2024 if you wish to continue using them. Following that date, AdView will be decommissioned. Anything not resubmitted at that point will be considered expired and no longer approved for use.

## Resources for NetXInvestor and Wealthscape Investor

Cambridge has created documentation and resources to assist you and your clients in navigating the recent changes with the registration process. Materials have been created and are available in the Cambridge Resource Center. These resources will continue to be updated. These resources can be found by logging into cir2.com and selecting Cambridge Resource Center in the black banner across the top of your page.

Once you're on the Welcome page you will select **Brokerage Operations**, followed by **Self Service**. From the Financial Professional and Client Self-Service Options page you will navigate to the general section where you will see Client Access with a link for both Wealthscape Investor and NetXInvestor.

Split between both client- and financial professional-facing materials, MarketCentral's sponsor section consists of a growing library of timely checklists, educational brochures, relevant commentaries, and more. #### **Bitcoin ETF Updates**

As announced in the January 11, 2024 <u>Special Report</u>, prior to effecting any transactions in bitcoin ETFs, financial professionals will need to complete a mandatory Cryptocurrency & Digital Asset training course through RegEd. The training course is already available to all licensed financial professionals and can be accessed by clicking the "Additional Training" menu option in RegEd.

Training is required for any financial professional who has clients trading these products, including unsolicited trades and/or trades placed by other financial professionals utilizing a split code with you.

Financial professionals are not permitted to trade bitcoin ETFs until they complete the training. This applies to transactions at our clearing firms (Pershing & NFS) and custody firms (Schwab, FIWS). Any trades completed before training completion are subject to being broken, with corresponding losses being the financial professional's responsibility. Additional measures, including Letters of Education and/or Caution may be issued for failure to take the training.

As an update to the Special Report, Cambridge has determined that VanEck Bitcoin Trust (HODL) will no longer be available for purchase. Current clients will not be required to sell out of existing positions, but HODL will be blocked from future purchases.
